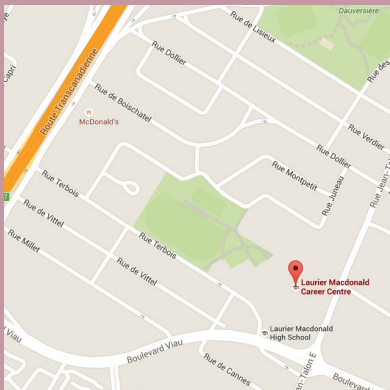
For admission to a program leading to a DVS* with the prerequisites in Category 1
